

# Major Talking Points

### March 24, 2000

The S&P 500 index reaches an all-time intraday high of 1,552.87 during the dot-com bubble.

Dot-com bubble peaked in March after a massive period of growth from 1994-2000. The crash lasted until October 9, 2002. Most internet stocks lost over 75% of their value during this period.

October 11, 2007

The S&P 500 index hits intraday record high of 1,576.09.

Financial Crisis of 2008 peaked in October of 2007 and lasted through a 38.49% loss in 2008.

#### March 9, 2009

The S&P 500 index closes at 676.53, its closing low after the onset of the 2008 financial crisis and the Lehman Brothers' bankruptcy.

Marks the largest bear market run to date.

# March 28, 2013

The S&P 500 index ends at 1,569.19, surpassing its previous record closing high set in 2007.

It took over 65 months to reach the previous high closing.

#### March 9, 2019

The S&P 500 index celebrates the 10th anniversary of the longest-running bull market, closing at 2,919.

This all started post-crisis low on March 9, 2009, and an unprecendented rise of over 330% in a 10-year period.

#### **July 10, 2019**

The S&P 500 index hits 3,000 for the first time.

This marks the index having 22x earnings, or 30x average earnings, which is its highest valuation in history.

#### March 17, 2020

The S&P 500 index drops to 2,458.
